
Fall 2017 General Education Curriculum & Structure (Int'l Undergraduate Students)



General Education Course-taking Notes for the International Students of 105 Academic Year

- A. The international freshmen enrolled for the 106 academic year must take general education courses for 28 credits, including fundamental compulsory courses (14 credits), liberal art elective courses (14 credits) and physical education courses (0 credit).
- I. The international students MISSING the Chinese proficiency test should take
- 1. Fundamental compulsory courses (14 credits), including Chinese (10 credits) and English Reading (4 credits).
- 2. Liberal art elective courses (14 credits), which include:
- Liberal art elective courses taught exclusively in Chinese: at least 4 credits (excluding those who pass the tests given by the course instructor)
- Pre-requirements for the liberal art elective courses taught exclusively in Chinese: the completion of freshman Chinese (4 credits) or qualification of Chinese proficiency TOCFL Band A level.
- 3. Physical education course (0 credit): a compulsory course for freshmen and sophomores (threshold 60 points or more)

- II. The international students PASSING Chinese proficiency test should take
- 1. Fundamental compulsory courses (14 credits), including Chinese (10 credits) and English Reading (4 credits). For Chinese, Chinese for general students (4 credits) is required, and the rest of the 6 credits for Chinese must be replaced by the Chinese courses listed in the classic field of general education (excluded from the credits for literal art program).
- 2. Seven liberal art elective courses (14 credits) of any fields (exclude the liberal art elective courses specific to Chinese-proficient students).
- 3. Physical education course (0 credit): a compulsory course for freshmen and sophomores (threshold 60 points or more).
- B. Because of class schedule conflict for the compulsory courses opened by the departments at KMU or the unavailability of the courses for the original grade level, the international students enrolled after 105 academic year (including students transferred from other schools or transferring to any departments at KMU during the current academic year) must accept the counseling offered by the Center for Languages and Culture to take the fundamental courses suitable closely to their proficient level for replacement.
